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WHAT IS A C.I. LEADER?

Continuous Improvement Leaders:

- Drive targeted, sustainable improvement in Quality, Delivery, Cost, and Innovation that is tied to Strategy and Daily Management
- Are responsible for facilitating continuous improvement activities targeted towards improvement priorities that will help the business meet its objectives
- Are positioned within an organization to facilitate change management, teach, and coach others in specific tools applied towards business problems
- Help leaders plan and prepare for requirements, resources, and execution of kaizen event activities while overseeing the sustainment of past activities

WHEN TO APPLY A KAIZEN EVENT?

What is a Meeting?





- Abbreviated duration of time (i.e. 1 hour)
- Discussion of key leaders/stakeholders
- Identification / Review of actions
- Work is assigned outside of the meeting
- Can either be consensusbuilding or directed by leaders

What is a Kaizen Event?



- · One to five day event
- Preparatory work required with clear problem-statement worked on
- Engaged participation of key leaders/stakeholders
- · Cross-functional participants
- · Clear process is followed (tool)
- I . Consensus building
- Work is accomplished during the event
- Clear Improvement Metrics
 - · Clear Action Plan
